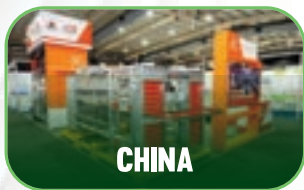

AGRICULTURE SECTOR INSIGHTS: SOUTH AFRICA

South Africa's agriculture sector is a vital component of its economy, contributing to food security, employment, and export earnings. **It contributed 10.3% of South Africa's GDP (2023).**

Key Trends & Market Dynamics

Consolidation of Commercial Farms: The average commercial farm size has steadily increased from approximately 1,640 hectares to 2,113 hectares. This growth reflects a clear trend toward larger, more consolidated farming operations within the commercial sector.

Mechanization & Adaptability: The adoption of modern machinery is reflected in highly dynamic year-on-year equipment sales. Following a 17% increase in 2022, sales declined briefly in 2023 and 2024 before rebounding with a robust 27% year-on-year rise in early 2025.

Cultivation Methods: South African farmers frequently integrate both open-field and covered cultivation, dynamically selecting the most suitable approach based on specific crop requirements, resource availability, and immediate market demands.

Fertilizer & Nutrient Management: While fertilizer consumption has declined in recent years due to rising global input costs, usage remains above historical averages. Moving forward, the adoption of sustainable farming practices and precision agriculture will play a key role in optimizing nutrient management, balancing productivity with environmental responsibility.

Major Agriculture Crops: Maize, wheat, sugarcane, citrus fruits, grapes, apples, avocados, nuts, and vegetables.

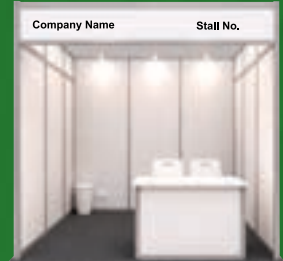
